Students, their parents, employees, and potential employees of the Estill County Schools are hereby notified that the Estill County School System does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, religion, marital status, sex or disability in employment, vocational programs, or activities set forth in compliance with the Title II, Title IV, Title VI, Title IX and/or Section 504.

The Estill County School System offers the following vocational education programs for students in grades 9-12: Agriculture, Family/Consumer Sciences, and Business Education. The following vocational school classes are available to students in grades 10-12 either on site or at the Area Technology Center in Richmond, KY for all students regardless of race, color, national origin, including those with limited English proficiency, sex or disability in grades 9-12: Auto Mechanics, Carpentry, Electricity, Health Services, Machine Shop and Welding.

The Adult Education program provides for continuing education, attainment of employment skills, for family literacy education, and for the attainment of a GED.
